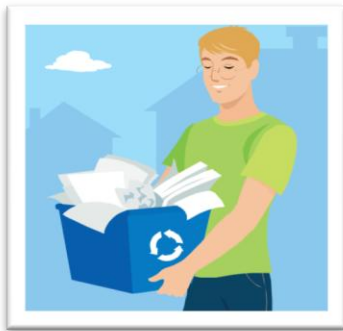


2010-2011 TOWN OF PLAISTOW RECYCLING INFORMATION

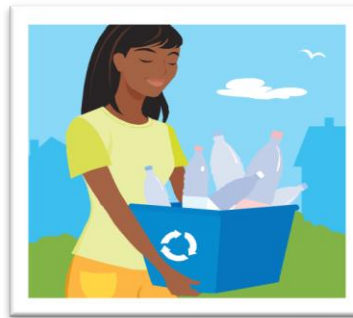


Paper



Place beside
or on top of bin
tied or inside
paper bags

Containers



All containers must
be rinsed and placed
inside the bin

Recycling -- it's easier than you think!

Be Green-Environmentally and Economically, it's the right thing to do!

Paper

- Junk mail, greeting cards, magazines/catalogues
- Newspapers (with and without inserts)
- Office paper, paperback books
- Books with hard covers taken off
- Phone books, brown and white paper bags
- Juice Boxes and Milk Cartons (rinsed)

If you can rip it, you can recycle it!

Corrugated Cardboard

- Flatten boxes into 3 x 3 squares max bundled and tied
- Cereal/cracker boxes
- Pizza boxes

Metal Containers

- Aluminum cans (deposit/non-deposit)
 - Metal food cans with/without lids
- NO** cans/bottles containing paint, aerosol or hazardous materials

Glass Containers

- Bottles/jars (all colors & sizes); food and beverage containers
- NO** broken or other glass such as light bulbs, window
Auto glass, mirrors, dishes, glasses, Pyrex or ceramics

Plastic Containers

- Bottles, cups, jars (may leave caps and lids on)
 - All labeled #1 to #7 recycling symbols on bottom of container
- NO Styrofoam, NO plastic bags** (recycle at your local supermarket)
NO motor oil or chemical containers

→Collection of recyclable materials must be curbside by 7:00 a.m. on your regular collection day **every other week***

→Please keep separate from your trash whenever possible.

→Containers with a recycle sticker may be used in addition to bins**

**Whenever a scheduled collection day falls on holiday, that day's collection and all remaining collections for the week will be delayed one day. Friday's collection will be on Saturday.*

*** Recycling stickers may be obtained at Town Hall, 145 Main Street M-F 8:00 a.m.-4:30 p.m.*

WHITE GOODS

(Dishwasher, Stove, Clothes Washer/Dryer, Hot Water Tank, Freezers, Refrigerators, Air Conditioners)

White Goods pick-up is the 1st Saturday of every month. Please call JRM at (800) 323-4285 to be placed on list for pick-up. There will be a \$25.00 charge per item.

Cathode Ray Tubes (CRT)/Computer Collection

CRT's (computer set up-monitor, processor, keyboard) or TV by calling JRM at (800) 323-4285 to schedule a pick-up. There will be a \$25.00 charge per item.

Non-Metal Bulk Pickup

JRM will collect non-metal bulk items during the week of October 26, 2010, on your regular scheduled day. All residents may put out items (i.e., furniture, carpet cut 3' lengths, bundled and tied and other non-metal items that will not fit into a 30 gallon barrel/bag). These items, too, must be placed at curbside by 7:00 a.m.

The Town of Plaistow is pleased to announce some changes to our solid waste and recycling programs in for our residents.

Starting on June 26th, 2010 JRM Hauling & Recycling will be the new solid waste/recycling firm serving the Town. As part of this new service contract, the Town of Plaistow will be seeking to enhance Plaistow's recycling program to make it easy to be **GREENER!** Let's face it, it's easier to be **greener** than it was 20 years ago, and more and more people are introducing green into their everyday lives. Under the new contract, JRM will be working with the Town on a campaign to increase the amount of recycled materials and decrease the non-recyclable material that is thrown away in Town.

The good news is that there are a lot of residents in Plaistow recycling. The not-so-good news is that, as a Town, we have a low level of recycling—only 11%. Additionally, some residents aren't sure exactly what they can and can't recycle and, as a result, many items that can be recyclable are not finding their way into the recycling stream.

We want to encourage everyone to consider increasing what they recycle this summer. Recycling is just one way to make Plaistow a cleaner, healthier and more attractive place to live and work. Environmentally and economically, it is the right thing to do!

We can't do this without you! Increasing our recycling decreases our cost for trash removal!
