

**Approved Amendments to Subdivision and Site Plan Regulations
2008-2009 to Submit to the Code Book Company
(Voted on at December 3, 2008 Planning Board Meeting)**

Are you in favor of the adoption of an amendment as proposed by the Planning Board to the Plaistow Subdivision Regulations as follows:

Modify Article VII, Design and Installation of Infrastructure, Section 235-34, Runoff, erosion, and sedimentation control, by adding a new paragraph as follows:

C. Silt socks shall be used as the primary erosion control methodology. Other methods may be used in addition to silt socks. The Planning Board may approve methods other than silt socks if the applicant can demonstrate to the Board that those methods will provide superior erosion control.

Are you in favor of the adoption of an amendment as proposed by the Planning Board to the Plaistow Subdivision Regulations as follows:

*Modify Article II., General Provisions, Section 235-12, Paragraph B (2) (d), second sentence, so that it reads, "The total fee is the sum of all applicable fees described in the "Plaistow Fee Schedule" and by deleting subsections 1 through 12 in the same paragraph. And by replacing paragraph (c) (3) [a] as follows:*

***"The initial escrow amount is listed in the "Plaistow Fee Schedule."***

Are you in favor of the adoption of an amendment as proposed by the Planning Board to the Plaistow Subdivision Regulations as follows:

Modify Article IV., Plats and Data For Final Approval, Section 235-22, Fees and Charges, to read as follows: "the applicant shall establish an escrow account with a minimum amount listed in the Planning Board "Plaistow Fee Schedule."

Are you in favor of the adoption of an amendment as proposed by the Planning Board to the Plaistow Subdivision Regulations as follows:

*Modify Article IV., Plats and Data for Final Approval, Section 235-22 (F) by replacing paragraphs 1 and 2 as follows:*

***1) All site plan and subdivision fees must be paid as called out in the Plaistow Planning Board Fee Schedule."***
