Plaistow Recreation offers a wide variety of programs for the children of Plaistow. Our goal is to provide quality opportunities for all children; we rely on volunteers to help make this possible. Our philosophy is for the most children to play ball learning the right age appropriate techniques and the opportunity to play more consistent ball both during the regular recreation season and the summer tournament season.

If your child has played one year in T Ball they may be eligible to move up to Pony League. This opportunity works well for the younger ball players so they will learn age appropriate skills. All the towns are working together on this concept. Our ultimate goal is that we all work together to provide all our children a good, positive, fun learning experience that will carry over with them when they all attend the Middle School and play together. We are looking for volunteers to help make this season the best ever, please sign up. We have coaching clinics and help from the leagues to get us up and running. Everyone has something to offer.

Baseball/Softball registration will be held on Saturday, November 5, 2011 from 8:00 am to 11:00 am at the Vic Geary Senior Center. Registration will be accepted on first come, first serve basis: when a league is full no more registrations will be accepted, and there will be no exceptions to this. Don't miss out, please sign up early. You may mail in your registration after November 5th BUT if it is received and the age division you are requesting is full you will **not** be eligible to play. **Try outs are tentatively scheduled for Saturday, February 18th, 2012 at the Timberlane Middle School. February 16th a message will be on the Recreation phone (382-5200 ext 18) web site www.plaistow.com, Face Book - Plaistow Recreation and cable tv channel 17 confirming this date and time for tryouts.**
