**MEETING CALLED TO ORDER: 8:07am** 

M. Sumner invites Mark Mitchell of Dore & Whittier to present the color schemes. M. Mitchell shows option 1 and option 2 on the screen and passes out samples. Discussion ensues. Chief Jones states the most popular option amongst the Police Department was option 1. Chief McArdle states his department did not vote but he feels option 1 is neutral and the best choice.

Consensus amongst the committee is for option 1. There is also consensus for the Town Seal to be placed in the location of the circle on the plan.
