PUBLIC SAFETY BUILDING COMMITTEE MINUTES

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER: 8:04am

J. Sherman motions to approve the minutes of 10/27/16. Second by B. Kiszka. Vote: most in favor, 1 abstain (M. Dorman)

<u>UPDATE OF PROJECT ACTIVITIES TO DATE:</u>

Chief McArdle states a water line will be put in. It was approved at the Board of Selectmen's meeting on 11/07/16. A hydrant will be put in behind the new building. It makes sense to put the water line in now rather than digging up the road in the future. We do have a GMP that reflects the price presented last year, however the scope has changed to reflect items removed from the project as part of the Value Engineering effort to get to this GMP.

Also, a request has been made to modify the middle Bay Door on the Fire Station to a height of 14 ft. This will allow for aerial equipment to fit into the bay.

The foundation of the new building is in and you can see where the road will go. We are seeing progress.

Chief Jones agrees we can see progress.

- B. Kiszka mentions checking into folding doors for the Fire Station Bay to see if they are less expensive.
- S. Fitzgerald mentions we are thrilled to have the GMP. There was concern that the scope of work might not fit in with the estimated cost from last October. There are a few minor issues to be worked out with the architect and the construction team. He mentions some unsuitable soil found during excavation. It will be removed. There is a possibility we could find more due to the

prior use of the land years ago. It was decided to rent a piece of equipment to heat the soil and keep the project moving if we run into winter conditions. We are trying not to interrupt construction. The project looks great and will be evolving over the next few weeks.
