PLAISTOW COMMUNITY GARDENS AT TERRA FARMS
TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Thank you for your interest in the Plaistow Community Garden. The Community Garden will be located at 148 Main Street, on the Terra Farms property. Interested applicants will be approved on a first come first served basis and must be a Plaistow resident and/or Community organization. A fee of \$25 for a 10ft X 10ft garden space or \$35 for a 10ft X 20ft garden space and must be made at the time of application. Checks may be made payable to the Town of Plaistow. Veterans and youth organizations will receive a 25% discount. This is an environmentally friendly garden, Think Green Plaistow! This project is being managed by the Plaistow Recreation Department, Garden Sub Committee and the Plaistow Lions Club.

- Respect all gardens.
- Only products listed on the attached approved list will be used in the garden (please see list attached).
- Supply own tools and equipment for care of plot. Small rototillers and weed whackers are acceptable.
- Keep garden plot free of weeds, rocks, debris and dispose of them in composting areas.
- Your plot will be overturned, fertilized and composted by the land owner at beginning of season.
- Notification as to date of first planting will be available at season start and is weather permitting. Planting dates will be established as the weather permits.
- Water will be available at the garden. Please turn off the water after use.
- Mulch and compost will be available.
- Do not leave open containers of water.
- No alcohol, no smoking, no pets in the garden.
- Tall crops will be planted in designated areas.
- Fall clean-up of plot and removal of personal items by November 15.
- Garden will be overturned in the fall by the land owner.
- Please monitor your children to show respect for the gardens.
- Parking in designated areas only and use entrance to the garden.
- Please respect the private property of the land owner and stay on paths.
- Hours are one hour after dawn to one hour before dusk on Monday to Saturday. Sunday hours are 1 pm to one hour before dusk.

Unattended plots will be brought to the attention of the Garden Sub Committee. If not corrected, the gardener will lose privileges and forfeit donation

I agree to participate at my own risk and agree to hold land owner and the Town of Plaistow harmless from any liability.
