#### Warrant Article P-28-08: Establish a Police Vehicle Capital Reserve Fund

Shall the Town Vote to establish a Police Vehicle Capital Reserve Fund for the purpose of purchasing or leasing new or used police vehicles and to raise and appropriate \$100,000 to be deposited into this account with \$100,000 withdrawn from the Unassigned Fund Balance? The Board of Selectmen shall be the agents authorized to expend these funds. The Capital Reserve fund is being created pursuant to RSA 35:1. (Majority vote required)
