Critical facilities, dams, bridges and evacuation routes were provided by the Town of Plaistow, with assistance from NHDOT for bridges and the NHDES for dams. Information was gathered to accompany the development of a Hazard Mitigation Plan under the guidance and funding of the NH Office of Emergency Management. March, 2004, and subsequently updated in 2011.

Base data (town boundaries, hydrography, roads, railroads and utility lines) are taken from the USGS Digital Line Graph data, 1:24,000, as archived in the GRANIT database at Complex Systems Research Center, Institute for thestudy of Earth, Oceans and Space, University of New Hampshire, Durham, NH; 1992-1999. Roads have been updated from work done by Rockingham Planning Commission and NH Department of Transportation. Partial updates have been completed through 2000.
