Project Update - Upcoming Site Activities

The Beede Site Group prepared this project update to inform our neighbors of upcoming field activities at the Beede property. This summer the following activities are scheduled to occur on-site in preparation of the thermal treatment of deep soils anticipated for spring of 2015:

- Off-site disposal of three existing soil piles on-site (approximately 1,200 cubic yards)
- Abandonment of over 100 existing PVC wells (removal and grouting)
- Grading of the future thermal treatment area

Upon completion of the site prep project, additional work will begin and will continue through the fall. This work consists of:

- Installation of a system of monitoring, injection and extraction wells for a total of 265 wells that comprise the thermal treatment system network.
- Construction of a concrete equipment pad
- Unifil will construct a natural gas line to the Site
- Unifil will install a new electric line from the groundwater treatment building to the thermal treatment area

This work is similar in nature to the work previously conducted at the Beede property with off-site trucking of the soil piles through the new 221 Main Street entrance and use of a drill rig for the well abandonment and installation activities. This construction should be less disruptive to the neighborhood than that completed in 2012-2013.
