- ▶ Paint Thinner & Stripper
- ▶ Polish (Furniture, Metal)
- ▶ Propane Tanks (for Grills)

What is expected of me when I show up at the HHW Collection?

Site Volunteers will be available if you have questions and they may ask you to participate in a short, anonymous survey while you wait. Specialized HHW staff will unload and sort your hazardous waste so you **can stay inside your vehicle for your own safety.**

COVID-19 safety precautions for the 2020 HHW Collections.
Attendees MUST:

A. STAY IN YOUR VEHICLE

B. Place your waste in the car trunk or truck bed.(not your backseat) Please open your trunk when on site. Staff will then remove materials for safe disposal.

C. **DO Not** bring containers you want back (i.e.- fuel cans, plastic storage tubs) to limit contact between attendees, staff and volunteers.

D. Wear a mask when near people and a vehicle window is down.

Questions:

1. *Can a business participate-* NO, these collections are strictly for residential waste. You can call Tradebe, Inc. and they can help you with your disposal. This includes schools, and municipalities.

2. *How do I dispose of acrylic/latex paint-* ACRYLIC/LATEX PAINT MUST BE DRIED and can then be placed in the trash.
