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HIGHWAY LABORER/TRUCK DRIVER

The Town of Plaistow is accepting applications for candidates to fill the full-time position of Highway Department Laborer/Truck Driver.

The Highway Laborer will be required to perform semi-skilled labor and skilled with heavy duty trucks and/or light duty motorized equipment. A Class B CDL driver's license is required with DOT medical card. Duties performed will depend on the crew assignment and time of year requiring an adjustment to schedule as directed by supervisor. The Laborer position tentatively will work Monday through Friday from 7:00AM until 3:30PM, 6:00AM to 4:00PM during the summer months and must be available for inclement weather events. Must be able to perform strenuous physical labor, occasional heavy lifting, and perform heavy manual work outdoors in varying weather conditions and snow removal. Candidates for this position should possess the ability to understand and comply with verbal and written instructions and to maintain a variety of records is necessary. A successful candidate should also have the ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with employees, other agencies, and the public. Candidates for this position should be highly organized, energetic, motivated, and dependable.
