## What is Hepatitis A?

Hepatitis A is a highly contagious virus that can cause liver infection. The virus spreads easily from person to person through contact with objects, food or drinks contaminated by small amounts of stool from an infected person.

People with substance use disorder · Men who have sex with men  
People experiencing homelessness · People recently incarcerated

## What are the symptoms?



Yellow skin or eyes



Abdominal pain



Nausea



Fatigue



Dark urine and/  
or gray stools



Vomiting



Loss of appetite



Joint pain



Fever
