

Plaistow Summer Concert Series—All concerts begins at 6 PM

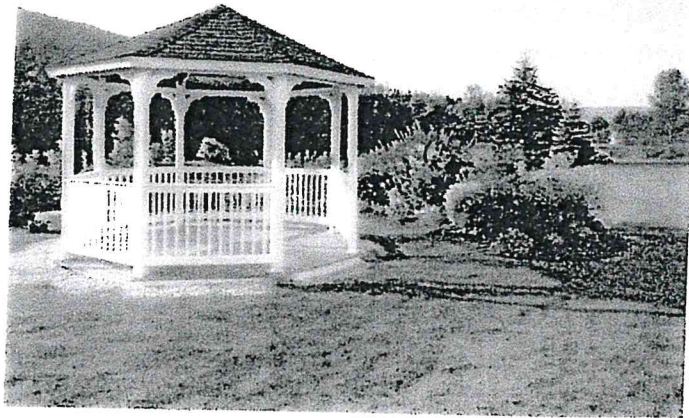

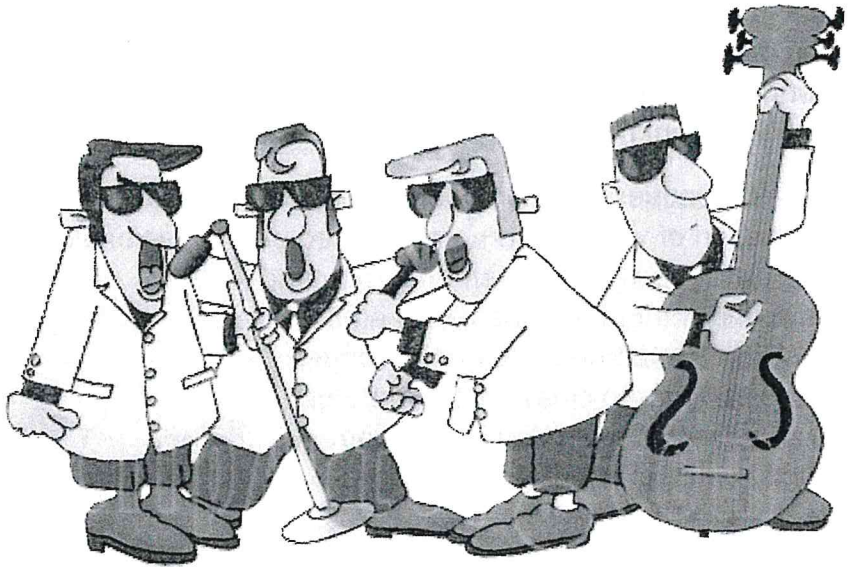

August 1 – Tom Towler Band -A gritty, country leaning roots rock band, The Tom Towler Band is best when they're in front of a live audience.
