Covid Safety Recommendations

In an effort to maintain Trick or Treat in the safest way possible and to reduce the spread of Covid-19, Town Officials are reminding residents that Halloween is completely optional, and it is their choice to participate or not. Those who choose not to participate should simply dim their lights or leave their outside lights off.

Families are reminded to take the following precautions if they choose to participate in Halloween activities:



Stay home and do not participate in Trick or Treat if you are not feeling well.



Wear a cloth mask over your nose and mouth when trick or treating or when handing out treats. Have hand sanitizer available as needed.



Consider setting up a table in your driveway! Driveways offer up more room to roam than a traditional walkway, porch or doorway and can even sport more fun and frightful décor! Position the table to maintain a safe distance from the little goblins. Try and keep interactions brief.



Instead of a communal bowl of treats that children will be constantly reaching into, have “grab & go bags” of treats or individual treats spaced out on the table that each child can take. Sanitize the table and replace treats between visitors.



Avoid large groups of people or confined spaces and try to stay at least 6 feet from others, including when accepting treats or handing out treats.



Follow normal Halloween safety practices. Always carry a flashlight, never go out alone, only go to homes with lights on, inspect all candy received, and discard any unwrapped candy.
