Application packets for employment with Plaistow Summer Recreation Program are available at the Plaistow Town Hall and on line at [www.plaistow.com](http://www.plaistow.com). Vacancies include Assistant Director, Counselors and Counselors in Training positions.

Assistant Director wanted for Plaistow Summer Recreation's program. The Assistant Director shall be responsible to plan and implement age appropriate programming that relate to the curriculum theme for summer campers and staff. The Assistant Director shall also serve as a resource staff person in a team environment to ensure the success of the summer program. The Assistant Director shall be under the direct supervision of the Director of Summer Recreation Program. Starting pay is \$9.75/hour.

Counselor's work involves planning and running summer programs and activities for children. This employee reports directly to the Summer Recreation Director. Counselors need to exercise supervision of small and large group activities with children and assists with the daily function of the program. Position involves running, walking, lifting, swimming, hiking and a variety of other physical recreational activities. This position is in a summer recreation program which is an environment that requires a moderate to high level of sustained physical activity. Starting pay is \$8.50/hour.

The Summer Recreation Program is housed outdoors at our PARC facility located at Old County Road. This is a minimum of a 7 week commitment and we are looking for individuals with great leadership qualities, who enjoy children and have sound decision making skills.
