**2 Bag/Barrel Trash Limit.**

**(Two 36 Gallon Barrels /Max Weight 50 pounds – this went into effective 9/1/2011)**

Multifamily & Condos will be allowed the equivalent of 2 barrels p/unit. Over-throw stickers for additional Barrels/Bags are available at Town Hall for \$2.00

Frequently Asked Questions

How Many Recyclables Am I Allowed To Put Out?

You can put out as many recyclables as you want. Pick up is Bi-Weekly.

Illegal Dumping

The Town will regularly monitor areas that have historically had dumping issues. We encourage residents to report offenders as well as engage the cooperation of their neighbors for the success of the program. Residents can report illegal dumping at 603-382-5200 x 266.

How Do I Dispose of Couches Or Other Large Items?

Bulky waste (Mattresses, sofas, chairs) will continue to be picked up curbside at no extra cost. Limit is one bulk item per week. Electronics can be recycled curbside with the purchase of a \$25.00 sticker, obtained directly from JRM @ 800-323-4285.

Recycling Bins

Any container up to 36 gallons can be used for recyclable items. Stickers are available at Town Hall for your containers. Stickers are marked comingled.

Acceptable Recycling Items

Residents can now recycle ALL Plastics, #1 - #7 (excluding #6 – Styrofoam.) Butter/Margarine tubs, yogurt cups, six & twelve pack rings, bottles, jars, glass & aluminum. Empty non-hazardous aerosol cans. Newspapers, magazines, phone books, catalogs, paper, cardboard, envelopes, & junk mail.

Unacceptable Recycle Items

No broken glass such as light bulbs, window or auto glass, mirrors, dishes, glasses, Pyrex or ceramics. No Styrofoam or packaging peanuts. No Plastic wrap, newspaper sleeves or plastic film. No napkins, tissues, toilet paper or soiled food wrappers. No metal rings/clips from notebooks. No motor oil or chemical containers. No cans/bottles containing paint, aerosol or hazardous materials. **Material cannot be placed in plastic bags, must be loose in container. Plastic bags are not acceptable.**

Residents may also dispose of

1 Automobile Tire per week with the rim removed. Push Style Lawn Mower with the gas tank removed.

White Goods / Computers & TV's

Metal appliances are called “White Goods”. Residents are required to call JRM @ 800-323-4285 to schedule a pick up. There is a \$25.00 charge for each item. The Town has to pay this amount to have these materials taken away. White Goods collection includes, Air Conditioners, Refrigerators, Stoves, Water Heaters, Dehumidifiers, Freezers, Dishwashers, Ovens/Ranges, Washers & Dryers, Televisions and Computer Monitors.

Yard Waste

Yard Waste can be taken to the Highway Garage on Old County Road off of Wilder Drive seasonally. The facility is open May through November two Saturdays a month from 7 am to 3 pm and two Wednesday evenings a month from 4 to 8 pm. These times are dependent on weather/facility conditions. Brush, tree tops, limbs, saplings and tree cuttings to include attached leaves must be five inches in diameter or less, untreated wood, timber or boards are acceptable materials. A detailed list can be found in the Town Report and on the Town's Website under Highway Dept. **Building material waste can be brought to the Raymond Dump for a fee, telephone 603-895-6273.**
