PAPER & CARDBOARD

NEWSPAPERS AND INSERTS
JUNK MAIL AND PHONE BOOKS
MAGAZINES, CATALOGS AND REPORTS
ALL NOTES, COPY OR SCRAP PAPER
PAPERBOARD (CEREAL AND CRACKER BOXES)
PIZZA BOXES
CORRUGATED CARDBOARD (FLATTEN AND BUNDLE)

GLASS, PLASTIC & METAL

GLASS BOTTLES AND JARS – ALL COLORS AND SIZES
ALUMINUM, TIN AND STEEL – CANS, LIDS, CLEAN TRAYS AND FOIL
PLASTIC CONTAINERS – NUMBERED 1-7, WITH THE RECYCLING SYMBOL ONLY
PLASTIC FOOD CONTAINERS WITH THE RECYCLING SYMBOL ONLY

RECYCLING PREPARATION

DO'S

RINSE CONTAINERS FIRST

PLACE LOOSE CONTAINERS IN RECYCLING BARREL – **DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS TO HOLD RECYCLABLES**

PAPER AND CARDBOARD PRODUCTS CAN BE PLACED IN PAPER BAGS OR CARDBOARD BOXES, IT IS NOT NECESSARY TO USE CONTAINERS

GLASS, PLASTIC AND METAL CAN BE MIXED TOGETHER

DON'TS

NO PLASTIC BAGS (GROCERY BAGS, BREAD BAGS, PELLET BAGS ETC. AND OTHER BAGS WITH THE SYMBOL CAN BE RECYCLED AT YOUR LOCAL GROCERY STORE)

NO STYROFOAM

NO HAZARDOUS WASTE ITEMS – PAINT, AEROSOL, GAS, OIL, EXTINGUISHERS, ETC.

NO BROKEN GLASS – DISHES, PYREX OR CERAMICS, WINDOW GLASS, ETC.

NO FLORESCENT BULBS, TVS, MONITORS, OR ELECTRONICS

NO STRING, ROPE, FISHING LINE, METAL WIRE, CHAIN LINK FENCING

NO UNIDENTIFIABLE PLASTICS (NO SYMBOL ON CONTAINER) – PLASTIC HANGERS, CLAMSHELLS, SMALL CONTAINERS WITH NO NUMBERS
