Dear Planning Director Cashell & Chief Building Officer Dorman,

ConvenientMD Urgent Care has a prominently located and highly regarded facility in the Greater Exeter community, located 1.8 miles from the Exeter Fire Department. My department has an excellent working relationship with ConvenientMD and responds to calls from ConvenientMD for patients with life threatening conditions requiring transfers to the Emergency Department. My perspective in writing this letter based on my department's interactions with the clinical team at ConvenientMD, our experience with the patients we transport from their facility, as well as the personal experiences of my staff utilizing their facility.

ConvenientMD's scope of care is broader than other urgent care centers in the area, which results in patients with high acuity issues utilizing their facility. ConvenientMD's patients are under distress and in need of urgent medical care, which can lead to patients being distracted when searching for their facility. In addition, many of their patients travel from surrounding communities in search of ConvenientMD and may not be familiar with the facility. The ConvenientMD in my community has very large and prominent which is easily read from the highway (Route 101) and major road (Portsmouth Avenue) which intersect near ConvenientMD. Due to the nature of their services, their patients being in distress, and their patients often being from outside the area it's important that ConvenientMD's facility be easily identified by prominent signage.

I understand that Convenient MD is considering a location in Plaistow, and I wanted to let you know what a great asset they have been to us here in Concord.

The Boys & Clubs of Central NH serves a large percentage of low income families. When Convenient MD opened in 2013, Max Puyanik and Ben Collins immediately reached out to the Club to offer to provide \$20 physical exams to our members (or serve them at no cost if need be). Most schools, camps, childcare centers and sports teams require these exams on an annual basis. Having a place where caregivers don't have to deal with health insurance has been incredibly beneficial, particularly among the New American (refugee) families that we serve. As important, the facility's location is accessible and prominent, making more likely that all kids will get the care that they need.
